**Admission:** Adults \$5/Children \$3, Pit Pass: \$15 (must be 16 or accompanied by an adult)

### *Classes:*

Class 1 - 35 inches and under, DOT Tires - Full Body; Street Legal

Class 2 - 39.5 inches and under, DOT Tires - Full Body

Class 3 - 44 inches and under, DOT Tires - Full Body

Class 4 - Jeep, small SUV and pickup - Full Body; Street Legal

Class 5 - 44 inches and under, DOT Tires - (county only); Street Legal

Class 6 - Open 44 inches and over, (No buggy's, alcohol or N.O.S)

Street Legal Rules:

1. Factory windshield
2. Plated
3. Head lights
4. Vehicle registration required

### **PIT RULES**

Signed release form required to enter pit area. No alcoholic beverages allowed. Must be 16 or accompanied by an adult.

### **MUD RACE TECH & GENERAL RULES**

1. All drivers must wear a safety helmet and a seatbelt in all classes.
2. All classes cannot run alcohol, duel carbs or N.O.S.
3. Tool boxes, roll bars/cages, and spare tires must be fastened down. No loose objects in the back of the vehicle or in the driver's compartment.
4. Exhaust from engine shall be directed up, down or back so as not to blow toward the spectators.
5. Stage time for vehicles at the starting line is 3 minutes. No refunds if the driver does not show up. In case of a mechanical breakdown, driver must notify an official before the class starts to receive a refund for that class.
6. All vehicles will be required to have an adequate hook-up for rear pull-out. ¼ inch mounts with 3/8 inch bolts as a minimum. The board will have final say in this matter.
7. There will be no track vehicles, dual wheels, chains on tires, or wheels with extensions added on for traction.
8. Calipers will measure the tire diameter.
9. During a run, if a vehicle runs out of bounds, it will be disqualified.
10. All vehicles must be put in neutral immediately after being red flagged and must remain in neutral until vehicle is pulled out of the pit.
11. The driver will be the only person allowed in the vehicle during a run.
12. Any competitor found drinking an alcoholic beverage prior to or during the competition will not be allowed to compete in the event and there will be no refund.
13. No alcoholic beverages will be allowed.
14. Anyone hot-dogging or high speed driving in the pit or staging areas will be disqualified from the event. No exceptions.
15. Eye protection (i.e. face shield, goggles, safety glasses) will be required for drivers of vehicles without a full windshield.
16. All competitors must be at least 16 years of age and have a valid driver's license.
17. All vehicles must have an adequate and working braking system.
18. All fuel lines, coolant lines, belts and hoses must be in good condition.
19. Kill switch must be marked and be able to kill engine and fuel pump. Stock ignition will suffice.
20. Batteries must be mounted securely. No bungee straps or ropes permitted.
21. All vehicles must tech in and meet all tech rules pertaining to the class that the vehicle fits into. No vehicles will tech in on a trailer. No one will be allowed to unload in front of the tech area.
22. All vehicles not on trailers must be washed before leaving the competition area.

Management and/or tech officials have final judgment on any vehicle or class. In the event of disqualification, there is no refund.
